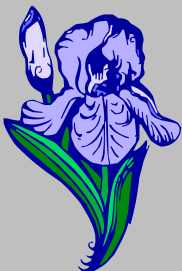

PAL has a new board member. Welcome to Andrew Londre.

Andrew Londre is a La Crosse County Board Supervisor (District 9), State Co-Director for the Young Elected Officials Network, Vice Chair of the City's Neighborhood Revitalization Commission, Vice Chair of the Powell-Hood-Hamilton Neighborhood Association, co-founder of the Move Out Sustainability Team, a senior at UW-La Crosse studying political science and public administration, and the newest board member of the Preservation Alliance of La Crosse.



Andrew and his family recently purchased a distressed three-story Victorian home in the heart of the Powell-Hood-Hamilton Neighborhood, hoping that the purchase and rehabilitation of that home could inspire and help turn around the undeserved reputation of that neighborhood. For years the home swapped hands of various owners and renters and was eventually foreclosed on. After sitting vacant for many months, it is now historically designated as the Milford Mosher house (located at 1028 7th Street South) and is almost entirely renovated. Andrew and his fiancé, Romi - a dietitian at Mayo Health System in La Crosse, plan to make the house their permanent home and eventually start a family there.

Andrew has been very active in local politics and has become a community leader in returning old La Crosse neighborhoods to their former glory. Now he is excited to discover how he can best serve on the board of PAL.

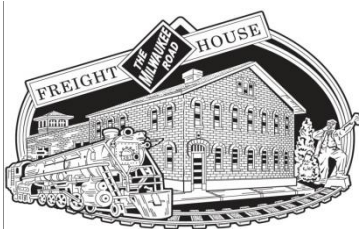

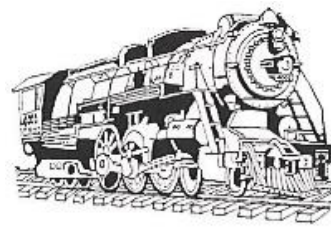

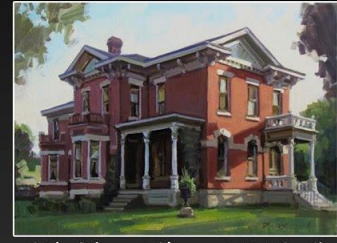
